Refurbishment and extensions at Worsley Leisure Centre will provide a refreshed and improved facility for the community

First floor works comprise of an extension to provide a new fitness suite, changing area and cleaners room.

The existing ground floor will also undergo extensions, refurbishment and remodelling works to create a cafe/viewing area, a new reception and office accommodation layout.

Lower ground floor works include refurbishment of the shower/change/WC/store and associated mechanical and electrical installations.

There will be external alterations including new steps and ramps to the proposed entrance area and associated drainage provisions and service connections.

The existing leisure pool facilities will remain open to the public throughout the duration of the works.
